

Boarding Policies for S5 Exam Period

(21st January – February 5th 2008)

These policies were designed in previous years, and revised this year after discussion with students, to help ensure optimum conditions for revision during the period of examinations. Students below S5 in the boarding house are asked to comply with the first 4 rules during this period for the benefit of the S5's.

1. **No visitors during this period.** Day students and other boarders are to keep away from the S5 boarding houses (unless they are other students who are visiting for the purpose of study and this should take place only in common areas).
2. During Study Hall, students must **work in their own rooms.** Students should try to work in pairs or larger groups outside of the normal Study Hall time; however, room 11 will be made available for group study during Study Hall if so requested in advance (see Mr. Eaton or your boarding parent - students taking exams should have priority in room 11).
3. **Music can only be played with headphones - no exceptions.**
4. **Boarding House TV and DvD players may not to be used during this exam period!**
5. **Trips off campus will be of limited duration and frequency.** Duka trips for S5's will be limited to 1.5 hours and no town trips other than school-organised trips at weekends are allowed.
